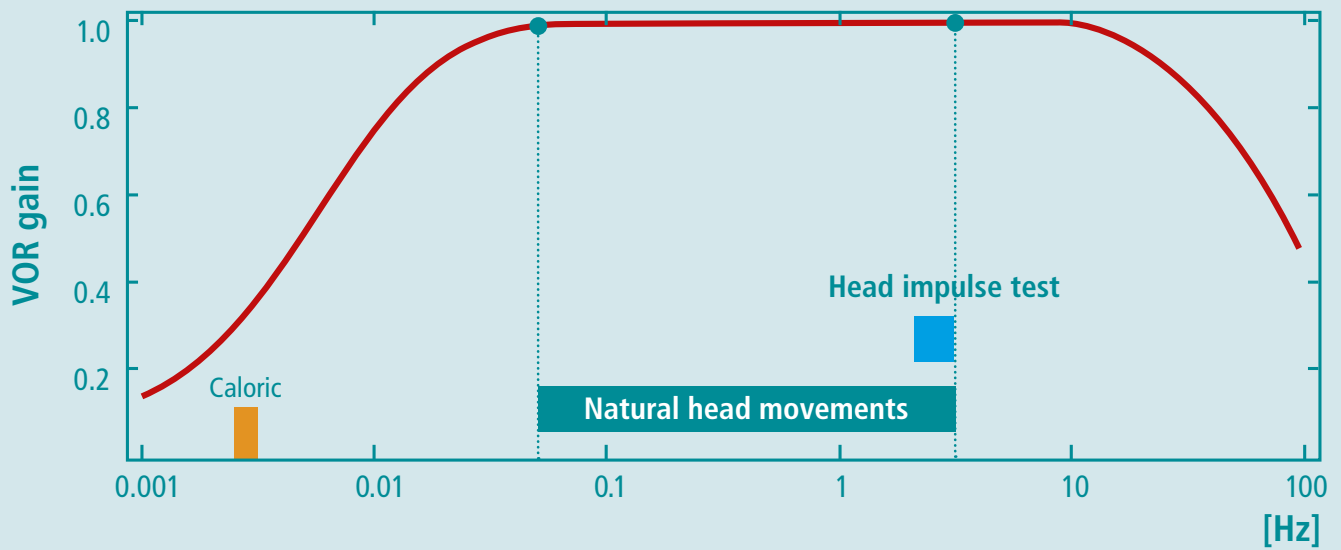


## DIFFERENCES IN THE OPERATIONAL FREQUENCY RANGE
